The recent examinations have again demonstrated the fact that under the present system of conducting them cribbing and other forms of cheating have grown to such proportions that some measures must be taken to remedy these evils. The notorious inefficiency of the method of vigilance by instructors is the strongest possible argument for a change in the mode of conducting examinations.

The question of a satisfactory substitute is a problem in college administration which has been neglected too long already, and it is high time that the matter should receive the serious consideration of the faculty and student body. The extension of the exemption system simplifies the problem greatly, but does not entirely eliminate the evils. Some form of an honor system is imperatively demanded by present conditions, but to be successful it must be founded upon a sentiment that will not tolerate any violations of its provisions. Can a system suitable to conditions at State be formulated? If so, is the standard of student honor high enough to support it? If our college is, as it should be, a place for the development of character, would not the change prove beneficial to each person who would come under its influence?

These questions demand the thoughtful consideration of everyone interested in the welfare of Old State.
