2. School of History, Political

porated more or less exten-
sively into all the four years'
courses. A separate course
in Philosophy is offered, and
other courses may be had.

Course in Agriculture (four
years),
Course in Agriculture (two
years),
• Course in Forestry,
Special Creamery course
(eight weeks),
Correspondence courses
(Home Reading and
Study).

4. School of Natural Science:

Course in Industrial Chemis-
try.

5. School of Mathematics and Physics:

Course in Mathematics,
Course in Physics.

6. School of Engineering:

Course in Civil Engineering,
Course in Electrical Engi-
neering,
Course in Mechanical Engi-
neering,
Elementary course in Me-
chanics (two years).

7. School of Mines and Metallurgy:

Course in Mines and Mining
(four years),
Short course in Mining (two
years),
Special Students in Mining
(no time limit).
