It were folly not to face the fact that the Association needs a building of its own. The organization is cramped now through lack of proper facilities, and what will it be when the enrollment of the college reaches and passes the

thousand mark? At the present time when the plans of the college are broadening to such a degree, and new buildings are projected for every department, the needs of the Christian Association cannot be overlooked. If the college is to grow and expand as its friends hope and expect, the capability of the Association must grow with the college. Otherwise a most disastrous condition will result, both to college and Association. If the Association is necessary to "State", it must keep up with the growth of "State".

The Association has outgrown three things,—(1) the spirit of apology, (2) its stage or precarious existence, (3) its rooms. That the first is true may be seen by a glance at the membership rolls, which include a majority of the recognized leaders in this college world. In the meetings, in the various canvasses of the student body, in the public references to the Association this note of apology is not sounded, because the undergraduates do not expect it to be sounded.
