

### The Recent Debates.

Our varsity debating team was defeated by Dickinson College in the final debate of the Intercollegiate Debating League of Pennsylvania last Friday evening. The chapel of Franklin and Marshall college at Lancaster, Pa., was chosen as neutral ground for the debate on the important question: "Resolved, That corporations engaged in foreign or interstate commerce should be licensed by the Federal Government and subject to its supervision and control." Dickinson upheld the affirmative, while State had the negative. The large audience was much interested in the good points brought out by both sides. Our men deserve great credit for their untiring efforts in preparation for this debate and are to be congratulated on the good impression they made. This debate makes the Dickinson team champions of the league.

The presiding officer was Prof. J. M. Chambers of Franklin and

Marshall College. The judges were L. E. McGinness, A. M., Superintendent of Schools, Steelton, Pa.; Rev. E. T. Jeffers, D. D., President of Collegiate Institute, York, Pa.; Rev. George Israel Browne, St. Paul's Protestant Episcopal Church, Harrisburg, Pa.

The debaters for State were: G. W. Groff, '07; H. M. Braucher, '08; A. A. Borland, '09; with H. H. McCreedy, '10, as alternate. The Dickinson speakers were: G. R. Hull, '07; A. C. James, '07; W. H. Michaels, '07; and W. H. Norcross, '07, alternate.

On the same evening State's second team debated with the Juniata College team at Huntingdon on the same question. State's men were: C. E. Myers, '08, W. R. Lams, '10, W. A. Haven, '09, and R. R. Dry '08. Juniata was represented by J. D. Miranda, '08, J. A. Shock, '08, A. J. Culler, '08, and J. C. Fiora, '08. The decision was against State.
