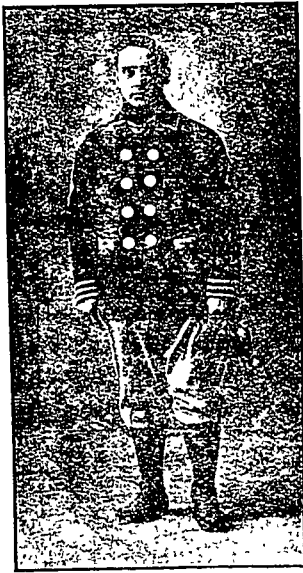


Prof. Foss Married

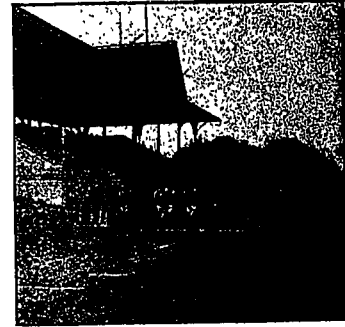
