James W. Stevenson, of Philadelphia, to be physics laboratory assistant.

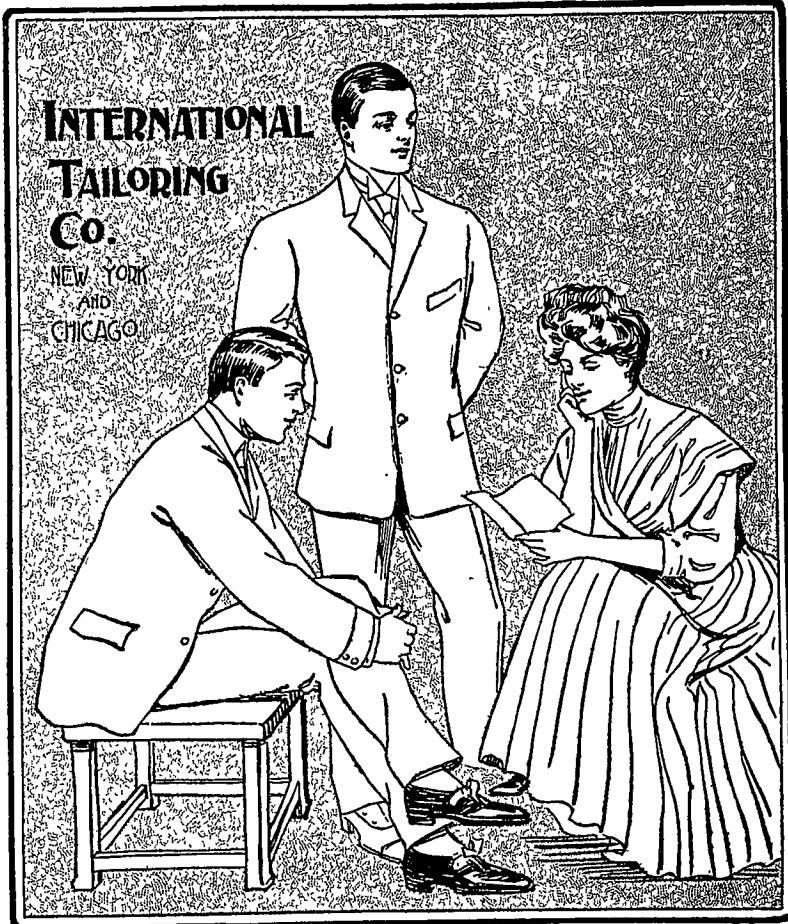
B. H. Goldsmith, a graduate of the Royal Bavarian Real gymnasium at Munich, Bavaria, to be instructor in German.
