

A Farmers' Train.

Arrangements have been completed by the agricultural department for the running of a "Farmers' Special" train over the Pennsylvania railroad in the southeastern part of the state. The trip will be made on November 10-12, inclusive. There will be twenty-five stops of forty-five minutes each at the various points along the line and at each of these the subjects of corn and alfalfa raising, soil fertility, increase of dairy profits, and others of interest to farmers will be treated. The plan has been tried in other states and has proved successful. Among those who will talk at the different stops are Professors Agee, Gardner, McDowell, Van Norman, and Shaw.
