C. F. York of the class of '76, the manufacturer of "Malena," has recently removed from Warriors-mark, Pa. to Detroit, Mich.

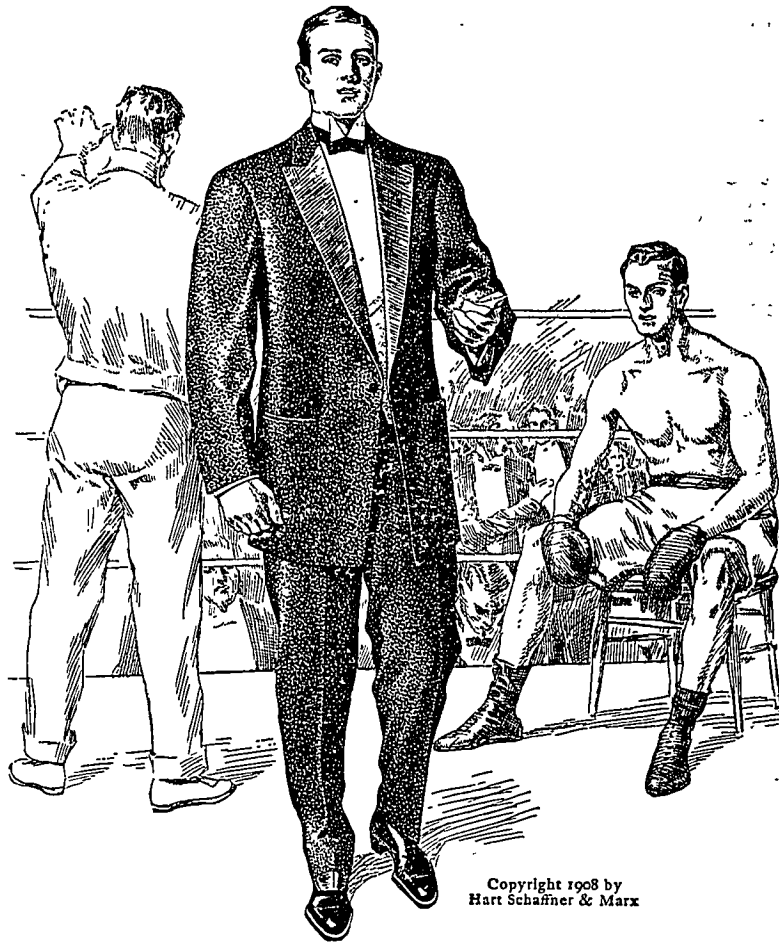
G. D. Barbey and C. H. Burns, both of the class of '08 have very good positions with the Bell Telephone company at Reading, Pa.
