S. Musser '05 is mining engineer at Vesta No. 4 Mine, California, Pa., for Jones and Laughlin Steel company.

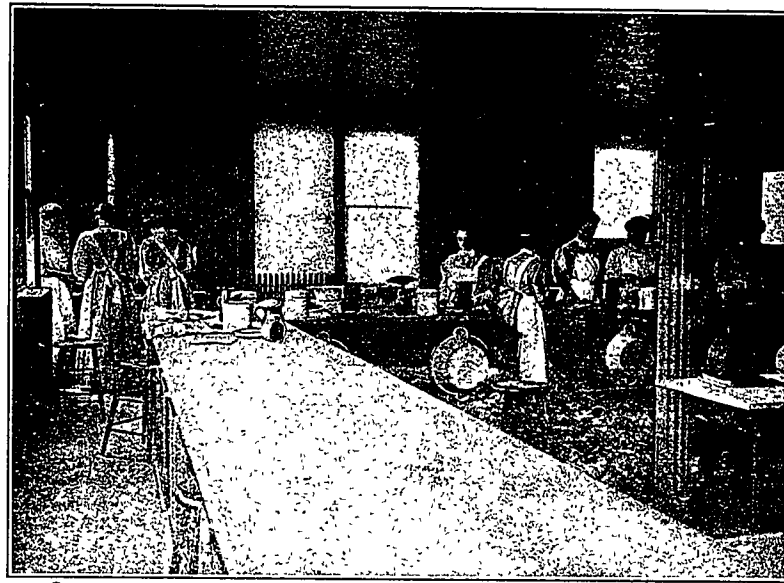
P. G. Elder '04 is superintendent of the Gypsum Mines at Grand Rapids, Ind., for the Pittsburg Plate Glass company.
