Rules for Interclass Track Meet.

The Athletic Executive Committee has drawn up a set of rules to govern the annual interclass track meet and these are here presented through Captain Maurhoff of the track team:

I. Five points will be given for first place, three for second, two for third and one for fourth place.

II. There shall be fourteen events: 100 yard, 220 yard and 440 yard dashes; half-mile, mile and two mile runs; 120 and 220 yard hurdle races; high and broad jumps; pole vault, shot put, hammer throw and discus throw.

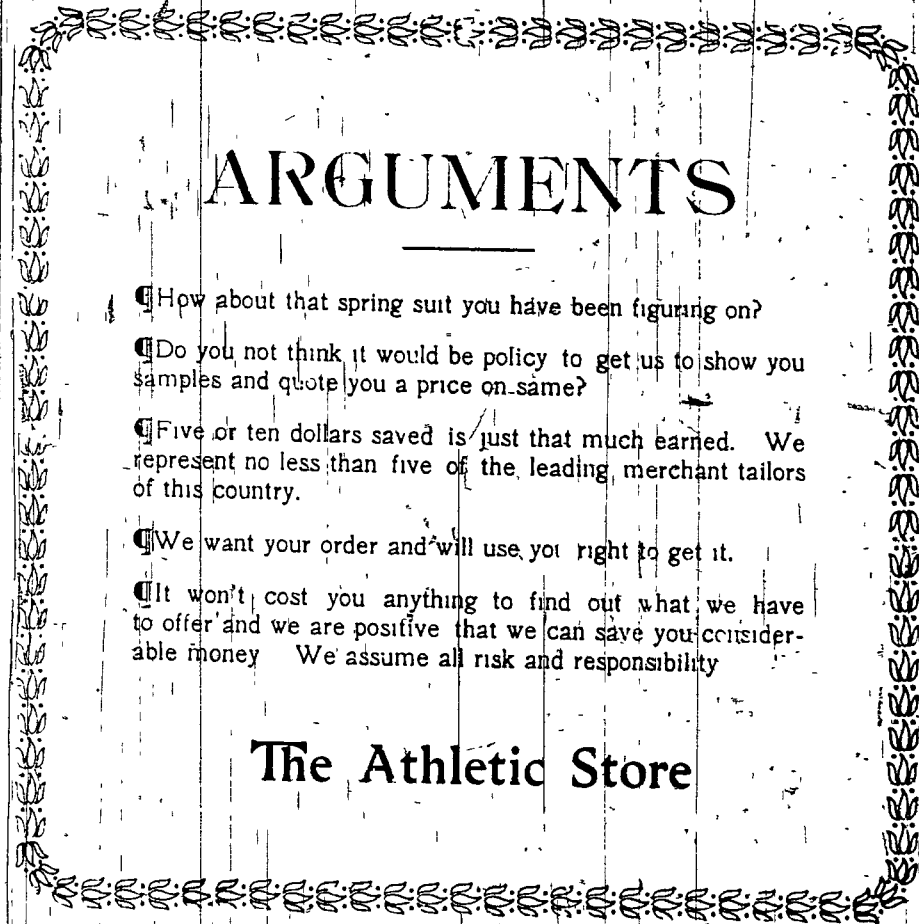
III. The entries from each class for each event will be limited to two.

IV. The officials shall be appointed by the director of athletics, the manager and the captain of the varsity track team.

V. For first place a gold medal will be awarded, for second a silver medal, and for third place a bronze medal.

VI. The winning team shall have its numerals engraved upon the interclass cup for track meets.
