#### Engineering Notes.

On Thursday of last week there were two lectures presented to the Senior engineers.

The first was presented by J. H. Crosman, Jr., on the subject, Organization and Administration of Corporations.

J. L. Minick '99 presented the subject, Mechanical and Electrical Engineering of Large Railway Terminals.

There will be a lecture before the combined engineering societies on Dec. 9 by Mason D. Pratt, of Harrisburg. The subject will be the "Comparative Utility of Water and Steam Power Under Differing Conditions."

Professor Breneman of the Department of Mechanics and Ma-

terials of Construction has ordered a 100,000 pound and 50,000 pound testing machine, a wire testing machine and a rattler among other machines which the department will have installed before next semester.
