

State 54, Wyoming Seminary 17.

Wyoming Seminary presented almost the same lineup on the Armory Floor last Friday night that they had last year; if anything, their five seemed stronger than that of a year ago. Then they lost 38 to 16, while the recent game was an overwhelming State victory—score; Penn State 54, Wyoming Seminary 17.

Our team showed consistent, heady, aggressive form and the comparison of scores would indicate that we have an even stronger aggregation than last winter. Captain Hermann is a good leader; always head over heels in the game himself, he still has time to call out the mistakes of his men on the floor, and the "Collegian" feels that his team is going to finish the season with a fine record—one that now stands three victories and three defeats. The interest in the floor game here was clearly shown by a good-sized crowd at Friday night's contest, and the students were very fair in giving a good share of their applause to each of the ten men on the floor.

Reed was up to his old tricks and performed in the style that has made him a name as one of State's standbys on the basketball floor. His record of eight goals from field was one almost equalled by Hoerle, who played in Reed's place at the beginning of the second half, "Bill" going to guard in Shore's place. Hoerle is light but very elusive and almost as good in getting around the floor with the ball as "Dutch" Hermann.

Blythe played an unusually good defensive game of the kind he is becoming more noted for the longer he plays under the Blue and White. James was given an opportunity to show his worth at Blythe's guard toward the end of the second half and performed well. Haddow at center out-jumped his opponent continually as he has been doing pretty regularly in all the games thus far played. Altogether our aggregation "looks good" and should

win the laurels that now promise to come State's way on the basketball floor this season, there is little fear that the student body will want to discontinue basketball here at State, where the winter sport has always been a popular form of amusement.

To night the Pittsburg Collegians meet the Penn State five on the Armory Floor. Last year the Collegians were beaten 55 to 29, Anderson scoring twenty one of the

visitors points. He is an old Lehigh captain and it is said that Troutman, another noted old Lehigh basketball player, will be with the Pittsburgers to-night.
