**Industrial Engineering Notes.**

The department of Industrial Engineering is completing the work on the new electric light poles, which will be used to replace all the present poles on the campus. The design was chosen after much investigation of the various kinds in use in the large cities of this and European countries. As soon as the work of casting has been completed, and one of the poles assembled and approved by the President the whole order will be filled as fast as the foundry can be operated.

The department has had much of this kind of work to handle this year. In all, the value of work for other departments, in construction and equipment, has amounted to nearly \$3000. All the work is done at absolute cost, and the saving in money and time, to some of the departments, has amounted to a considerable sum.

A new pipe shop and tin shop has been in operation this winter for the short course men, which has a very complete equipment for the accommodation of a class of ten or
