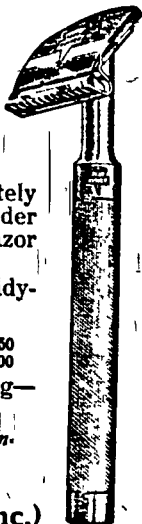

We Lose to the Collegians.

On Thursday, Jan. 20, fate descended upon our basketball team in the form of the Pittsburg Collegians.

All started well enough; Captain Hermann's five got a comfortable lead in the beginning and even after the visitors had gained a few points thereafter, the first half ended with State five points to the good.

At the opening of the next session things began to happen. Dolan and Artz made splendid shots from almost the middle of the floor and before one half the second period was gone the score was tied at thirty three. The students were cheering wildly at this stage of the contest for a basket to put the Blue and White in the lead, but although our players had numerous shots no scores were forthcoming. Pryor went in for McCague at this time

but the change did not affect the final tally to any visible degree.

All along, both teams passed well and managed to keep the ball away from their opponents when once their team-work was going. It was in accurate shooting that our team was excelled; however; State had more opportunities, but fewer goals. Undoubtedly the Blue and White team was decidedly off-color and the defeat was of the heartbreaking variety. Only five times in ten years has Penn State lost to an opponent on the Armory floor in a basketball game and it is no wonder that the players took the recent game to heart as they did. The final score was 40 to 37 against Penn State.
