The School of Mines and Metallurgy

As a part of the extension work which is being conducted by the School of Mines and Metallurgy in cooperation with the Y. M. C. A. Mining Institutes, Dean Crane has during the month delivered lectures in Latrobe, Castie Shannon, Irwin, Johnstown, Brownsville, Monongahela City, Scottdale and Punxsutawney

A small concentrating plant has been installed in the Ore Dressing Laboratories. It consists of a set of jigs a number of different types of hydraulic classifiers, a Wilfley table, and an automatic ore feeder.

The whole plant is motor driven, and adds greatly to the range of work that may be done in ore concentration in the laboratories.

The School has recently received two large shipments of ores for use in the laboratory work, one being a lead ore consisting of Galena in calcite, and containing a small amount of blende, donated by the Canada Smelting Co. from their Old Frontenac mine near Kingston Ontario, and the other a carload of gold-bearing
