"Industrial Class" Experiment Being Tried in Williamsport.

The following article is taken from the "Williamsport Grit" and gives a good idea of the work that is being undertaken by the Engineering School. Announcement was made last week of similar classes being established at Altoona in co-operation with the P. R. R. in their shops.

"Recognizing the urgent need for a more intimate relation between the great industrial centers throughout the State, and the state Technical college, The Pennsylvania State College, near Bellefonte, has undertaken to devise ways and means for getting into closer touch with the large numbers of people who are in need of, but unable to take advantage of, its magnificent facilities. In other words the aim is to bring the institution to those who are unable to come to it. This college is, peculiarly, for the people and by the people; for if the legislature should withdraw support, it would of necessity close its doors, as it is entirely dependent upon the state for support. It was established upon the grant of tracts of land by Congress in 1802, at which time Congress, and the legislature covenanted and agreed that Pennsylvania should create a college "to promote the liberal and practical education of the industrial classes in the several pursuits and professions of life"
