What certain other colleges have done for their students may be seen in part by the cuts presented here with. The sight of these commodious buildings should be an inspiration to

us. What others can do, the Penn State spirit can accomplish.

The following table shows the cost of student buildings at some other colleges and universities:-

The University of Illinois has organized an "Illinois Union" composed of undergraduates, alumni, and faculty for the purpose of erecting a student building. The University of Michigan and the Ohio State University secured their buildings in this manner. Donations from classes, from individuals, and from clubs were added to the proceeds of the college entertainments and all sums thus collected went to swell the building fund. Drown Hall at Lehigh was furnished almost wholly by the alumni subscribing according to their classes.

A Plan of Organization.

We must organize for the Student Building. Shall we have a Penn State Union, merging students, alumni, faculty, trustees and friends into a great organized army with a definite purpose and determination to win? Or shall we have distinct organizations for each of these bodies?

A compromise might be found in a central body with subsidiary committees representing each of these factors, the chairmen of which would constitute an executive committee for the whole.

Above all we need a leader. An enterprising, enthusiastic, politic man, who has the future of Penn State at heart, one who will sacrifice his present position for a year or two of service at small compensation in behalf of a cause. We need a man with initiative, with business instincts, and, if possible, with business training; a man who can see things in the large. Where can he be found?
