The White Slave Traffic.

An audience which completely filled the Old Chapel last Siturday evening listened to a talk on "White Slavery" by one of our Russian students, M. Zamoschin. The talk was given under the auspices of the Comopolitan club, and as their president said was one of the ways they had to indicate the attitude of the Club towards improving international relations socially as well as commercially.

Mr. Zamoschin deserves much credit for his comparatively clear delivery of the English language. He treated his subject from a psychological standpoint, dealing with theories and reasons for its existence, and diting certain characteristics of the Russian natives which foster the theory of "free love" His remarks were made cirectly against the Russian Church and seem to indicate that the source of the evil lies in the innermost parts of the church.
