Saturday evening, in the Auditorium, Mr. Bohner, Immigrant Work Secretary of the State Y. M. C. A., gave a most interesting lecture on the subject of immigration.

Mr. Bohner has had much personal experience with all classes and kinds of immigrants and has traveled through the countries from which many of them come, having but recently returned from a fourteen months tour in company with four other young men. This trip was made mostly by bicycle, the party spending five months in Rome, five months in Southern Italy, and four months in Hungary and Poland.

The lecture was illustrated by photographs taken by the speaker. They pictured the original home life of our immigrants and how much this has been improved by the number who have returned to their native land. Among the pictures thrown on the screen was one of the Cosmopolitan club of this college. In this connection Mr. Bohner said that these men were good examples of what our immigrants could do for themselves when given a chance.

The entertainment was fittingly closed by the singing of our National hymn by the audience.
