"Substitute for Kicking Goal-After a touchdown has been made the team making it shall be credited with five points and the Captain of the team shall translate 500 words of Caesar's Commentaries. If he does so without an error his team is given an additional point, the same as if a goal were kicked. If he fails the ball goes to the op posing team on the twenty-five yard line.
