INDIANS WIN INTERCOLLEGIATES

State With Crippled Team is Unable to Take Honors From Redskins.

In the annual intercollegiate track meet at Harrisburg, Pa., the Carlisle Indians decisively outclassed all of her opponents, rolling up a score of 52 points. State's team though miserably handicapped by the loss of her most prominent stars, who were unable at this time to make the trip, showed up well against the other colleges and university entered from this state.

The colleges represented in the meet with their respective scores are as follows: Indians, 52; Swarthmore, 25; Lafayette, 19; Bucknell, 17; State, 15 1-2; Lehigh, 7; Dickinson, 6; U. of Pitt 6; W. & J., 4 1-2; Muhlenburg, 2.

Six thousand enthusiasts were in attendance.
