vice of a man of such broad experience and recognized standing.

The foundations are being prepared at the rear of the Thermo laboratories for the reconstructed foundry. The portion of the annex now lying to the north of the existing buildings will form the moulding floor, while one half of the present structure at the rear of the Engineering building will be used as an L in which cupolas will be located. By this change a more adequate floor space will be obtained with greater convenience for efficient production. Cranes will be installed to transport the molten metal to all parts of the moulding floor. The other end of the building will be assigned for office and class room purposes.

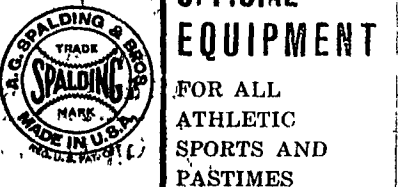
