Pitt took place and State＇s sons journeyed to Pittsburg undefeated nder their beloved＂Larty＂Vorhis while Pit inder．Captan Homer Roe was in lop－hoth form．＇Ere the whistle＇s echo had long ceased， that superb backfield quintet of the Blue and White－＂Larry＂Vorhis Bull＂，MbCleary，Lester Mauthe Heff＂Hirshman and＂Dutch Hermann－had swung into uncon－ querable motion．It was their last game for alma mater and Pittsburg－ ers had never seen such a football machine in action－more courage ous，more powerful and more sports man－like．Pitt，too，played a mag nificent game and Forbes Field wa dedicated to the annual State－Pit struggle with a stubborn brilliantly fought victory for State by the score of 5 to 0 ．
