Negotiations are being made for a meet at Scranton and for a Wednesday meet here with Penn. If these engagements are not secured our team has closed its season. It is unfortunate that we were not admitted into the Intercollegiate this year, but our standing as compared with the other teams can easily be figured out. We have defeated Lehigh, Yale, Columbia, and Cornell. Columbia won from Penn and Princeton. Cornell and the Navy have beaten the other important college teams. The Navy, the only team which could dispute our superiority, lost on her own floor to Yale and as we beat Yale on her own floor, our championship claim seems to be indisputable. For the great success of our team too much credit cannot be given Mr. Lewis, the Gymnasium Director. Night after night, for months he

has been coaching the men and getting them into shape. In his voluntary coaching he has been assisted by some of the older wrestlers,—Diehl, Neidig, Lesh, Knight, but the major part of the work has fallen upon his own shoulders. Practically the sole coach, he has developed a team that has beaten the best teams of the East; and when we think of our great bunch of wrestlers it is well for us to give the credit and praise that are due the man who has helped so much in attaining the honors. All of the men on the team have worked steadily for the glory of Old Penn State, and each one deserves a full share of credit for the honor they have given to our Athletics. All of the men above the 135 pound class will be here next year, and will form a strong nucleus for a 1912 team, but in Glanville, Neidig, Diehl, and Morrison we lose a quartet of excellent wrestlers who will be sorely missed.
