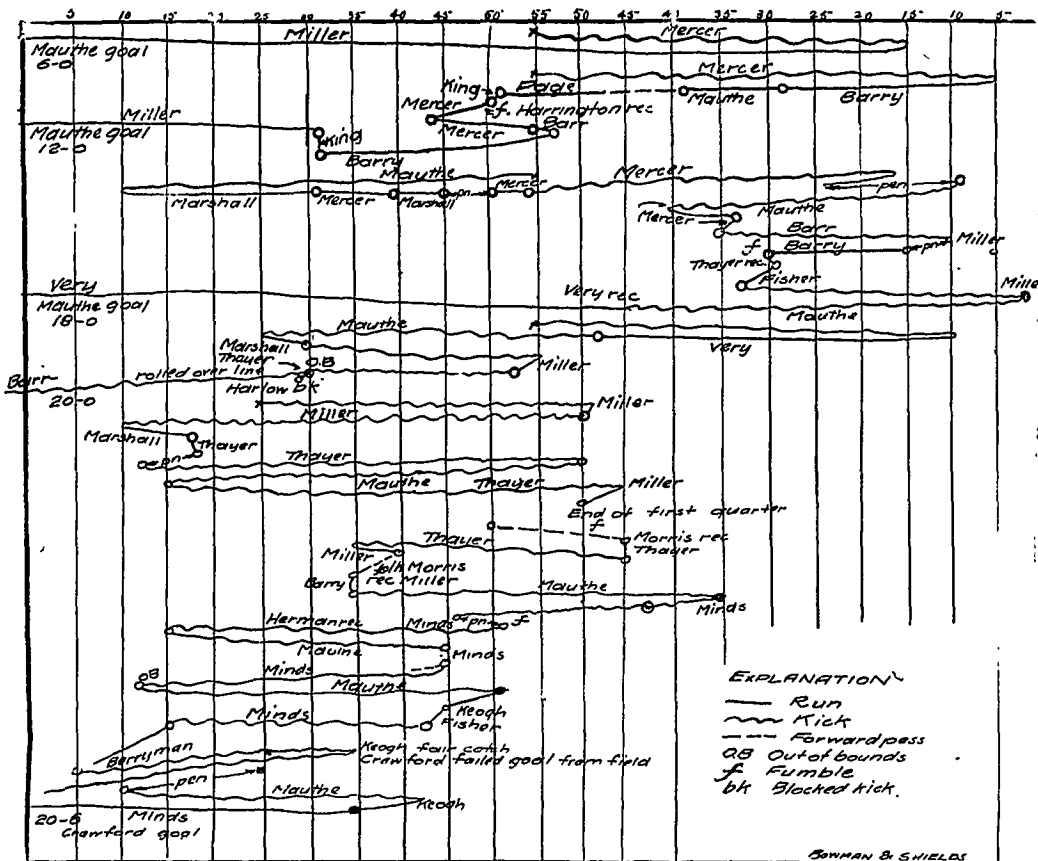

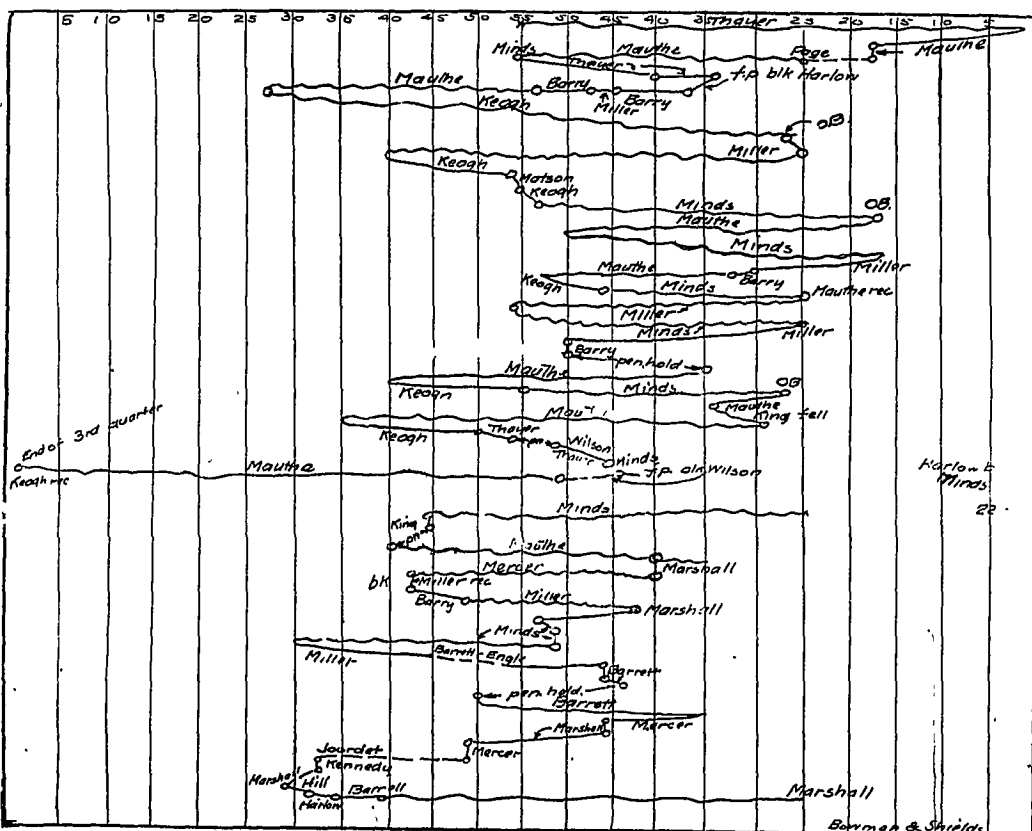
Y. M. C. A. Convention.
