He holds degrees from Columbia University and Kansas City Medical College. For the past four years he has been physician and director at Tsing Hua College, Peking, China.

Prof. M. G. Kains who was made the head of Horticulture has degrees from Michigan Agricultural College and Cornell University. He has recently been assistant editor of the American Agriculturist.

The new head of the Department of Public Speaking is Prof. J. T. Marshman who holds the same position in the Ohio Wesleyan University. He will give especial attention to Penn State's debating team which this year defeated Swarthmore, Franklin, and Marshall and Dickinson.

The Athletic association finds itself with the problem each year at this time of getting sufficient houses of entertainment for the athletics competing in the inter-scholastic meet. This year 150 men are expected to be here and this will necessitate the aid of the fraternities in as liberal a manner as possible. 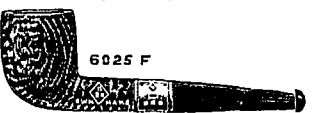
