

Sec. 10. Upon a second conviction a student shall be permanently dropped from college.

ARTICLE V.
Amendments.

Sec. 1. The adoption of these articles shall require a majority vote of the student body.

Sec. 2. After the adoption of these articles, a three-fourths vote of those assembled in a mass-meeting of the student body shall be required to amend them, providing at least two weeks' notice of such amendment is presented in writing at a regular mass-meeting.

Sec. 3. Repeal. These articles may be abolished by action of the faculty alone in their regular meeting after one month's notice to students and faculty or by a three-fourths vote of the mass-meeting consisting of two-thirds of the regularly enrolled students of the college after at least one month's public notice of such meeting.

FRESHMAN FOOTBALL SCHEDULE COMPLETED

Freshman Teams of Large Universities to be Scheduled in 1916.

Strongest Prep School Teams to be Met Next Year—Varsity Schedule Complete.

The renewal of football relations with the University of Pennsylvania is the most striking change which appears in the list of football games just announced for the 1915 season. The Penn athletic authorities invited Penn State to a renewal of the game under conditions which give promise of a pleasant future relationship.

The Harvard game scheduled for the third successive year is another prominent feature of the schedule as is the usual Thanksgiving game with Pitt. Lehigh affords a big home attraction on Pennsylvania day, and Lafayette is again met at Easton under the contract negotiated last year, which brings that team to Beaver field for the Pennsylvania day game in 1916. In addition to Lehigh four other strong home games are provided; Westminster college and Gettysburg again appear on Beaver field, while Lebanon Valley college, and West Wesleyan are new comers on the schedule. This list of opponents provides one of the strongest schedules in Penn State's football history.

One of the keenest regrets is the inability to repeat the Michigan Agricultural college game in 1915. The renewal of the Penn game made it impossible to accept Michigan's invitation for a game at East Lansing, and by reason of the previously scheduled game with Lehigh for Pennsylvania day the only possible date for a game at State College was not available. The "Aggies" by their clean, hard football of last fall won a place in the hearts of Penn State undergraduates, and it is hoped that this game can be renewed in the near future.

The list of contests for the 1915 season is exceedingly well balanced, the sequence of games being such as to provide ample periods of rest between the major games and to allow for the gradual development of the team. The distribution of the games is also most advantageous; the Harvard game giving competition in New England, and also with one of the Big Three; Penn and Pitt, Lafayette and Lehigh games touch the principal centers of Pennsylvania and afford a large percentage of the Penn State alumni an opportunity to witness the team in action.

In view of the comprehensive system of freshman development to be followed out under the one year rule, the schedule of games for the first year men has been materially strengthened. Efforts to schedule at least one game with the freshman team of a leading college are at this time unavailable. The prospects in this
