The 100-yard dash was also in dispute. Taylor of the Blue and White team ran it in the first time of ten seconds and his number was put up in the winter but at the awarding of prizes Taylor was given second honors and the first prize was given to Lawrie of Princeton who had come in second.

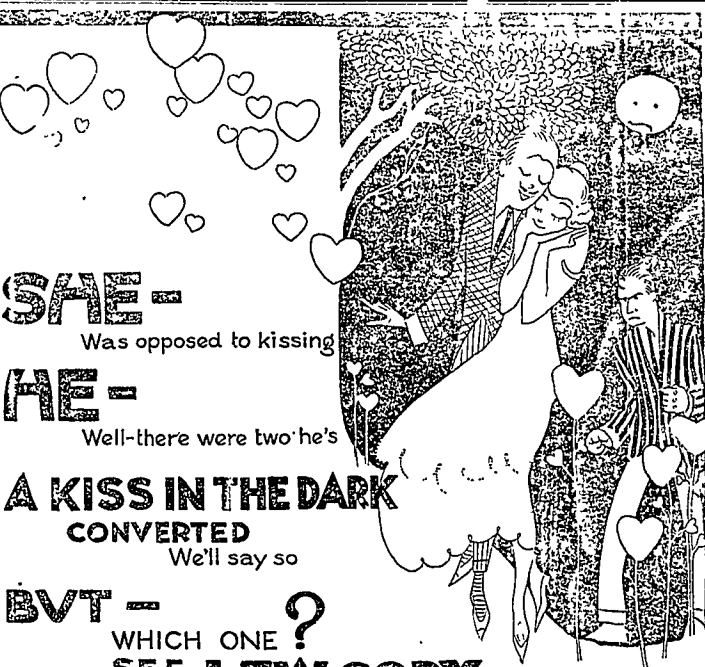

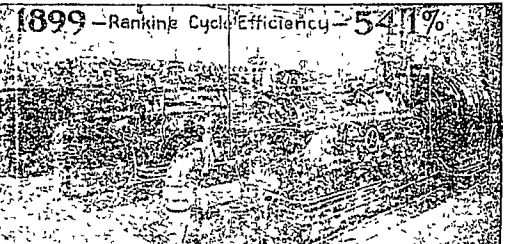
