

**COLLEGE MAINTAINS  
FREE HEALTH SERVICE**

Summer Session students, as part of their registration fees, pay fifty cents for the maintenance of the College Health Service, and this entitles them to free consultation and advice. All students are urged to consult the Health Service upon the slightest evidence of disease or injury. The college physician, Dr. J. P. Ritconour, and resident nurse, Miss E. V. Foreman, are at the service of the students and may be located at the Health Service building, situated in the orchard beyond the Liberal Arts building.

The College Health Service was founded primarily to prevent disease as far as possible among the students, to conserve their health in every way, and to treat the ill or injured when necessary. In addition to the Health Service building, which serves as office, dispensary and infirmary, an Isolation Hospital for contagious diseases is located south of the athletic field. Students who are ill and are likely to be confined to bed for more than twenty-four hours are required to enter the Infirmary, where they receive care and attention that it is impossible to give in the dormitories or rooming houses. This is done in order to keep the patients under closer observation and to prevent the spread of disease among the students.

Students who are confined to the Infirmary are charged at the rate of \$2.00 per day, which covers all expense for ordinary service and attention. Drugs and surgical dressings are furnished when possible at a nominal sum. Visits made by the College Physician to students at their rooms will be charged for at the rate of \$2.00 per visit.

The Dispensary hours for free consultation and advice during the Summer Session are from 10:00 to 11:00 a. m., and from 1:30 to 2:30 p. m. Except in emergency cases, the customary physician's fee will be charged for services rendered at other than regular dispensary hours.

**LIBRARY HOURS**

Two libraries are maintained by the college, the Carnegie Library, located just above the Armory, and the Agricultural Library, located in the Agricultural building. The Summer school students are urged to make free use of both of these libraries. The following hours will be maintained.

Carnegie Library—Open every day from 8:00 a. m. to 6:30 p. m. Open on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings from 8:00 to 10:00. Agricultural Library—Open daily from 8:00 a. m. to 12:00 m., and from 1:30 to 6:00 p. m. Will not be open in the evening.

**3000 FARMERS AT  
ANNUAL GATHERING**

Farmers' Week at the Pennsylvania State College, in spite of the fact that inclement weather interfered with attendance, was a great success. More than three thousand farm people visited the college farms and witnessed the many demonstrations showed for them during the three days devoted to their program. For the first time a Young Farmers' section was held, extending over six days, and the more than 200 boy and girl club workers who attended were greatly pleased with the results.

Ninety demonstrations were held in two days, Wednesday and Thursday. From fifty to two and three hundred farmers were in attendance at each of these and were favorably impressed. During the general meetings Fred Rasmussen, secretary of agriculture, said that for the first time in a generation there will be no food surplus, and conditions bearing famine will result unless a good price for their products is guaranteed to the farmer. Clifford Pinchot, forestry commissioner, said that the Pennsylvania farmer is today working harder for a smaller reward than any other class equally skilled. Lumber users in Pennsylvania can save \$25,000,000 every year in freight alone if timber is grown for local consumption in the state.
