**SPECIAL TALKS TO BE GIVEN BY DR. SPARKS**

"America the Heir of the Ages" is the title of the first of a series of historical conferences and talks to be given by Dr. Sparks during the remaining weeks of the Summer Session. The first meeting will be held on Saturday morning at eight o'clock in the Old Chapel and will be continued every Saturday morning from eight to nine-thirty if the interest and attendance warrant.

Before coming to the presidency of Penn State, Dr. Sparks was professor of American History at the University of Chicago for thirteen years and is well known as an authority on the subject. The class will be "go-as-you-please", with no registration, no class roll and no credit. It will be more in the nature of a conference and will deal with both content and teaching. A great many of the students will no doubt avail themselves of the opportunity that is being offered by Dr. Sparks.
