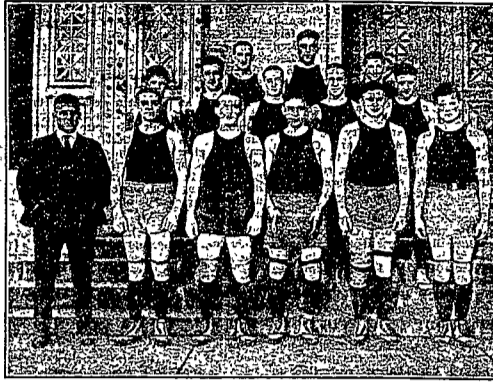
My Dear Editor: I think it may be a good idea for me to give you some statistics on "Daddy" Groff's work in China.

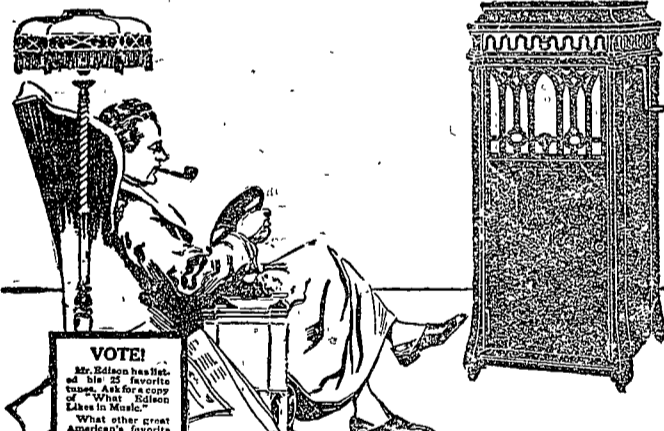
