With the change from fall to winter sports one hundred and twenty-two freshmen signed up for wrestling more than ever before in the history of the college. First year men who display ability are being chosen for the freshman team and all veterans who feel that they have possibilities and who have not signed up are urged to do so at once. Although a schedule has not as yet been completed, Manager W. C. Pierson is making arrangements for several meets on the home front and at least one meet away.

At a meeting of the Intercollegiate Wrestling Association last month several modifications were made in the rules of the sport, most important of which were that no matter what the cause of a default in a bout it will count five points, and that in case of an extra period after ten minutes of wrestling all previous advantages are to have no influence on the referee's decision. All of the changes are of temporary nature, as a committee headed by H. D. Bennett of Princeton, W. D. Stuart of the University of Pennsylvania and W. C. Pierson of Penn State was appointed to formulate in entire set of regulations to be put into effect in intercollegiate meets next year.

One hundred per cent participation by the eleven hundred new students would mean \$110,000 added to the campaign total, which would then leave not much more than half a million to raise before the desired goal of two million dollars is reached. Added to this some pledges from the few undergraduates of the sophomore and upper classes who could not go along in the drive last fall, and our financial drive will enable us to give the campaign an upward boost that should soon see the final goal in sight.
