Enough at Bethlehem and Penn & Phil-
adelphia. The Inter-collegiate will be
on March twenty-first and twenty-second
and will wind up the season.

Foremost among the contenders for
the 135-pound berth are M. L. Lehman
25 and E. A. Clegg 25 both men from
last year. Both men fought despera-
tely for the position last year with hon-
ors equally divided and finding from
previous practice another stiff battle
for the privilege of representation.
Penn State in the lightweight division
can be expected G. H. Hunter 24, a
veteran on the squad for two seasons
looks good for the 125 pound position
but both W. L. Sims 26 and W. C.
Dugay 26 will give him plenty of op-
position. Dugay, arrested in the 145
pound weight by the freshman team
last year but if he can make the weight
this year it will put him in a strong
aspect to the contest of the twenty-
five pounders.

The 135 and 135 pound berths are still
in doubt as it is not known whether
Cap. the Nut or can get down to his old
weight. In the event that the Nutty
Captain does not make that size he
will take "Dad Evans" old place in
the 145 pound class. J. L. John-
son is another excellent grappler but
his weight also is suspect. J. R. Lewis
24, a thirty-five pounder, and W. B.
Clark 25 and T. L. Gladwin 26, forty-
five pounds will furnish some stiff
opposition in their respective weights.

For the 135 pound class D. G. Ross
20, Pop. 1 from football team
F. Puthenore 25, vice-captain of last year,
and J. Dowd 26, captain of last year's
freshman team. J. L. Probst 24, star
tackler on the grid team is setting the
pace in the seventy-five pound class
with Bill House 20, S. Brumback 26
and J. Davidson 21 close on his heels.
The two candidates have sized up for
the heavy weight class J. Brumback 24
and J. April 26. Martin who has
wrestled in the Inter-collegiates for the
past two years, will probably represent
the Blue and White this year with
April who wrestled in the 135 pound
class on the freshman team last year
proving a valuable member.

W. Pearson 21 manager of the
varsity wrestling team is in charge
in arranging schedule for the fresh-
man matmen. The veterans have been
reporting regularly and under the super-
vision of Coach Deane several of the
first year men have displayed remark-
able ability. Manager Pearson was re-
cently honored recently when he was
placed on a committee by the Inter-
collegiate Wrestling Association to
draw up some new rules for the popular
college sport.
