Five Penn State Students To Be Candidates for Scholarships to Oxford

MEN MUST BE CHOSEN BEFORE NEXT OCTOBER

Pennsylvania is among the list of states to elect candidates for the Rhodes Scholarships to Oxford for the coming year.

Requirements A candidate to be eligible must be a male citizen of the United States, with at least five years' residence in the United States.

Method of Selection

Each candidate for a scholarship is required to make application to the secretary of the committee of selection of the state in which he wishes to compete not later than October twenty-fifth.
