Fraternity House Parties Open With Dances Tonight

Dean of Men Outlines Regulations - Affecting Observance of Pennsylvania Day

ALL RULINGS OF COLLEGE SENATE TO BE ENFORCED

With the official opening of House Party season tonight, the Dean of Men calls the attention of fraternities to the following rules, which have been adopted by the Board of Trustees and the College Senate.

Dancing at house parties shall not continue later than one-thirty o'clock on Friday night and twelve o'clock on Saturday night.

All men shall be out of the house at house parties and all women shall be in the houses within one hour after the dancing ceases on Friday and Saturday nights.

The presidents of the respective organizations giving dances and house parties shall be held responsible for taking proper steps to secure the observance of these rules by both active and alumni members and guests.

The following comments on the house party situation was given by Dean A. R. Warnock "Under request of fraternities groups made last spring, the College authorities have given permission to the fraternities this year to prove by their own methods that they can reform some of the conditions which have been criticized in house parties and dances in years past."

"I sincerely hope the fraternity group will accept its share of this responsibility and will not only see that all rules are observed to the letter, but will also see that, in all respects, the parties which they give are in keeping with the standards which we like to think we have at Penn State."

"I think it is especially important that all the girls as guests should be in the fraternity houses after the close of the dance. Most of the serious criticisms that has been made of house parties has arisen from instances which have occurred in the early part of the morning."
