



# A Toy-a Tool

 $T_{HE}$  first twenty days in December witnessed a big event in one man's life. They saw a toy grow into a toolone of the most useful in all history.

On December 1st, 1885 there was brought to George Westinghouse, at Pittsburgh, an uncommercial "secondary generator"-a scientific toy.
