(Continued from first page) This point from the State Supreme Court. A section of the bond issue act reads as follows:

Section of Act "If as approved by the Legislature a vote of the people of the Commonwealth at the municipal election to be held November 1925 or at the first election thereafter, whether general or municipal which may be determined by the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania to be a timely election for the submission of proposed constitutional amendments to the vote of the people..."
