The cast will be the same as that which performed on the western trip with the exception of W. P. Reed...

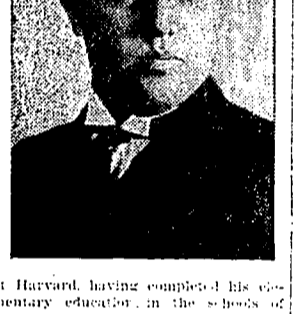

I. F. C. CONSIDERS RUSHING POLICIES FOR FALL SEASON

Regulations Will Be Submitted To Greek-letter Societies for Their Approval
