

SUPREME COURT DELAYS PENN STATE BOND ISSUE

1925 Bond Issue Also Delayed by Five Year Restriction Until 1928 Election

Adjutant General C. M. Pennell, in the name of the bond issue for the year 1925, has been delayed by the Supreme Court. The court has ruled that the issue cannot be put to a vote until the November election of 1928.

The delay is due to a provision in the constitution which requires that any bond issue must be approved by a majority of the voters in the county in which it is to be levied.

Graduates Show Great Interest in Gatherings and Picnics During Summer

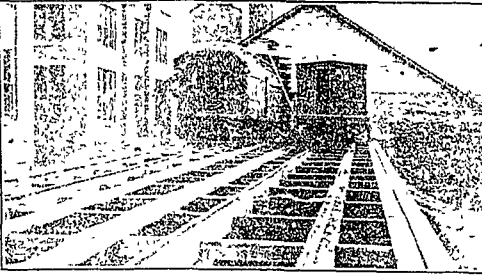
