Planning to make its courses popular this year than ever before, the School of Education has made numerous improvements in its Ex-tension work

A new office has been established in the State Chamber of Commerce Building in Harrisburg, in which Miss Mabel Kirk, a recent addition to the faculty, will assist Piof. P. A. Metz, the eastern representative of the work.

Not confining the improvements to one section of the state alone, the office of the Pittsburgh Teaching Center has been moved from the Central Y. M. C. A. Building to the Iron City college building. Mis. Ella Lobingies, formerly of the School of Education in the University of Pittsburgh, has been added to the staff to assist in the work in that city. The present enrollment in the Pittsburgh Teaching Center is larger than ever before in the history of the school. At the Johnstown division of the work eleven classes have ahead been organized and are in operation while plans are being made for the organization of three additional classes. Professor Green and his assistants are conducting extension classes in Natural Scince with large enrollments.

classes in Natural Scince with large enrollments, sear, there has been a great demand for extension courses of graduate character. The department is at present conducting graduate courses at Pittsburgh, liarrissburg, Altoona and Merritatown. Planner now under way to have Dr. D. A. Anderson conduct an extension course for the faculty of the Bloomsburg State Normal school. The total enrollment of students in the extension courses conducted last year was fifty-two hundred and present indications show that this high mark will be exceeded during the current season.


