to discuss the organization of that body. It is now composed of eleven judges and four deputy judges. These men are nominated by every county that enters the court, each state nominating no more than four. The judges are then elected by the League of Nations in session.

At the present time, although the United States is not in the court, the League elected Bassett Moore, a prominent lawyer of this country, to sit on the bench of the tribunal. As organized at present the World Court is ready for immediate action and all of its early decisions will be of the utmost importance because they will serve as precedent upon which a new code of international law will be built.

He urged that we enter the court so that those coming after us may have some means of international co-operation by justice and reason rather than eternal warfare.
