### ALUMNI AIRMEN WILL TELL OF HAWAIIAN TRIP

so remember Harry Wetzel '11 who is an aircraft builder at Santa Monica, California, and M S Q Corbett '11 who is doing experimental work in aviation at McCook field, Dayton, Ohio. Major Gillespie '17 is another Penn State flier who is making a name for himself in army aviation.

"The design in which Mr. Cocklin had an important part shows very thorough study of the numerous factors involved in developing a high powered plane of minimum weight, maximum carrying capacity and sea worthiness." Lieutenant Connell was complimented very highly by Commander Rodgers for his ability, good judgment and resourcefulness.

Both Connell and Cocklin led an active undergraduate career here. The latter will be remembered by the faculty as an instructor in descriptive geometry after his graduation as an electrical engineer in 1914. In 1917 Cocklin entered the employ of the United States Naval Board in Philadelphia as a draftsman and since then has been promoted until he is now a project engineer. In that position he was responsible

for conducting the design, construction and tests of the planes prior to the Pacific flight. He flew to the Pacific coast from Philadelphia to see the planes were in perfect condition for the project. Cocklin was a member of the COLLEGIAN staff in his student days, manager of his class basketball team and a member of the Eta Kappa Nu, honorary E. E. fraternity.

Lieutenant Connell  
 Lieutenant B. J. Connell '18 graduated from the civil electrical engineering course. He was also prominent in campus affairs, being manager of varsity tennis and track, club manager of track, tennis and football and captain of the cadet corps. He is a member of the Phi Kappa Sigma fraternity.

After graduating he joined the aviation service and went to the Grounds school at Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He learned preliminary flying and training at the air station at San Diego, California and went to Pensacola, Florida, for further instruction.

Receiving his lieutenant's commission after he was sent to the Canal Zone in 1922, Connell spent a year at Annapolis and another at M. I. T. in graduate work and was given a Master of Science degree. In September, 1924 he was ordered to the air station, serving as squadron engineer officer on the U. S. S. Wright. He was selected as pilot for the PN-9 for the Pacific flight by Commander Rodgers.
