## FRATERNITY MAT TEAMS ADVANCE IN TOURNAMENT

**Sigma Phi Epsilon Noses Out Omega Mu Rho in Close Match Tuesday**

Four teams moved a step closer to the cup awarded for inter-fraternity wrestling honors and as many more were definitely removed from the race in matches held in the Armory Tuesday and Wednesday evenings.

In Tuesday's meets Phi Delta Theta failed to put in an appearance and accordingly advanced Friends' Union to the next round. On the same evening Omega Mu Rho lost to Sigma Phi Epsilon grapplers, being forced to yield by the close score of thirteen to ten. S. P. E. won the first match by decision and the next two by falls. Omega Mu Rho took the two succeeding clashes by falls but their tarry comeback was not sufficient to overcome the early lead of their opponents.

Sigma Pi opened Wednesday's schedule with a 15-8 victory over the Delta Kappa Sigma aggregation. The victors scored three falls, each in less than three minutes, to win over their opponents who could only show one fall and a decision. In the next meet Kappa Delta Rho garnered three decisions but lost by a point to Sigma Phi Sigma who gained two falls. The match was undecided until the Sigma Phi Sigma heavyweight tumbled his opponent and won the meet.
