THREAT OF PUNISHMENT FEARED NO MORE--BRYAN

Sunday Chapel Speaker Says Christ Can Be Resisted But Not Ignored

"Hell's fire no longer frightens," were the opening words of an address delivered by Rev. W. B. Bryan, Jr., University Pastor of the First Presbyterian church, of Princeton, at chapel-guests in the Auditorium Sunday morning. He went on to explain that threats of punishment after death have no more effect than "Keep off the grass" signs.

Rev. Bryan continued, "We are all fundamentally lazy and it sometimes takes a blast of dynamite to move us. We like to remain in a comfortable position and not to be bothered by other things."

He believed that ignoring Jesus Christ in life today cannot be done, that he is everywhere but we can fight him, though the majority of those who do so are materialists after fame and money.

"The pastor closed with, 'We try to ignore Jesus but he draws us to him'."

Barbatti of Syracuse is an ideal fullback. The Orange "Big Bertha" is big and strong, an offensive line and a defensive wall. The brilliant Welch needs no argumentative substantiation for his position among the elite.

The second quartet composed of Rogerts, Pennsylvania, Clarke, of Syracuse and Flanagan of Notre Dame, halfbacks, and Diehl, Bucknell, full back is not far inferior to the first in all-around football ability.

Veteran Line Greenshields, Penn State's stellar tackle, is the only comparatively inexperienced lineman to make the first eleven. Paired with McManmon of Notre Dame he would be a tower of strength should the mythical eleven ever be assembled.

Hanson, the stellar Syracuse leader, and Singer, who starred for the Red and Blue against the Nittany warriors, earned the wing assignments. Hanson was named captain of the first squad because of his inimitable qualities of leadership.

The center of the second-team line presents a wall of strength, with McGee and Hastings as guards and Jack Butler, Pennsylvania candidate for All-American honors, in the center position. Hake and Flak are clever and powerful tackles with plenty of aggressiveness.

(Continued from first page) Miss Martha Jane Gobrecht '30, one of the outstanding performers of the last showing will appear in the fourth act with selections on the marimba.

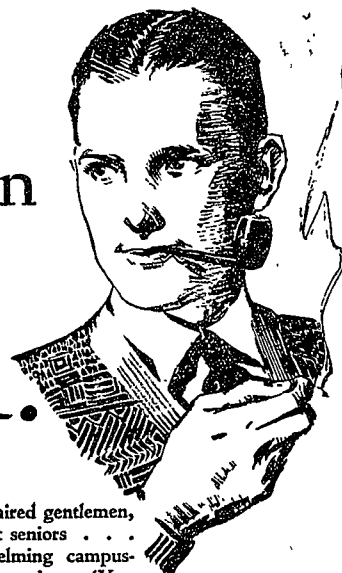
