

Lion Opposes Panther In Thanksgiving Fray

ished the famed defense of the Presidents. On November 17 Pitt invaded Lincoln, Nebraska, and battled the undefeated Cornhuskers to a fierce 0 to 0 tie. Cold weather and a muddy field retarded the usual speed of the Panther backs. Even so, the Nebaskans were completely outplayed. Sutherland's pupils made 8 first downs while their foes were unable to collect any.

Panthers Strong

Although losing 12 letter men from his 1927 championship eleven, Coach Sutherland has molded together a smooth-working and powerful team. With two of the best ends in collegiate football as a nucleus, the Pitt leader has developed a most effective forward wall. Donches and Guano, famed terminals, have been mentioned as all-American material by numerous sports writers and are widely heralded as the best ends in Pitt history.

Tully, 190-pounder, and Getto are the tackles supporting Guano and Donches. Captain Fox and Dimelio occupy the guard positions while Montgomery holds down the pivotal post. As an indication of the power of the defense developed by Sutherland, the speedy and rugged attack employed by Nebraska failed to penetrate the Pittsburgh line for even one first down. Washington and Jefferson tallied only a single first and ten and that came in the fourth quarter.

ter after the Pitt coach had replaced all his regulars. The Panther backfield will be composed of Parkinson, Williams, Unase and Edwards. The former is the Pittsburghers' main threat. Stationed at fullback, Parkinson has carried the burden of attack, using his 200 pounds to good advantage. Edwards, veteran from last year, will perform as quarterback while Unase and Williams complete the quartet as halfbacks. Baker, Rooney, Bowen, Wal-mechus and Goldberg are understudies who may see action.

Bezdek Primes Lions

Eager to break the streak of five successive reverses at the Pittsburghers' hands, Penn State's gym warriors are perfecting their offense, stressing co-ordination to a great degree. Scrimmages Thursday and Friday found the first two elevens battling each other, with Team A triumphant. The backfield of Wolf, Jamas, French and Diethrich displayed flashes of real form and on Friday ran a tough shot over the second team. Wolf and French scintillated with numerous gains around the ends while Diethrich and Jamas contributed yardage on line plunges. A passing attack with French throwing and Wolf and Diethrich on the receiving end was responsible for several touchdowns.

The contest Thursday will serve as

the finale for three brilliant Penn State athletes. Acting-captain Steve Hamas, Allie Wolf and George Delp. Steve has been Bezdek's most consistent ground-gainer, in addition to performing in good style on the defense. Allie is the main threat in the Lions' passing attack and will start against the Panthers Thursday. Penn State will enter the contest with seven sophomores in the line-up. Mike Kaplan and Earl Edwards will be stationed at the ends, while Shawley and Love perform at the tackles. Eschbach centers, completes the line with Martin and Zoulla, guards. Pan-accion, Delp, Stubble, McAndrews, Duvall and Curtiss will be held in reserve.

Steve Hamas will serve as fullback and Coop French, tucky little broken field runner, at quarterback. Allie Wolf and Frank Diethrich will oppose the Panthers at the halfback posts. Miller, McCracken, Evans, Collins and Hensle may see service as substitutes.

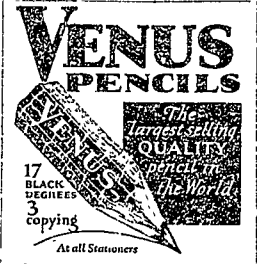
