Uansa broke loose around right end and galloped 40 yards for a touchdown, his second of the game. His kick after touchdown failed. Score, Pitt 20—Penn State 0.

The Lions threatened immediately following this score. Miller, who had replaced French, intercepted a Pitt pass and was chased out of bounds on his own 30-yard mark. He hit through left tackle for 2 yards on the next play. Evans made a yard at right tackle and Miller crossed to Collins who was tackled on Pitt's 14-yard line.

Diedrich was unable to gain at right tackle. Collins made a yard through the same position. Kaplan received Miller's forward for a first down on Pitt's 25-yard mark. But another pass, thrown by Miller, was intercepted by Uansa on his own 15-yard line and hopes for a score waned. The remainder of the period Penn State was in possession of the ball. The Pitt defense stood fast, however, whenever its goal was in danger.

Hood Scores Penn State made a slight touchdown gesture again but it was immediately halted. An exchange of kicks found Berden's charges in possession of the ball at the oval back 3 yards. Miller hurled a long pass to Kaplan who grasped it for a first down on Pitt's 33-yard line. Miller

made 3 yards around left end but the Panther defense became impregnable at this point and the Lions lost the ball on downs.

Unable to gain, Pittsburgh laced to Miller who fumbled on his own 22-yard mark and Walchus, substitute for Williams, recovered for Pitt. Hood and Walchus then alternated on plunges through Penn State's weakened line until the ball was placed on the 1-yard mark. Hood flung himself for the final touchdown. Uansa failed to kick goal. Final score: Pitt 26—Penn State 0.

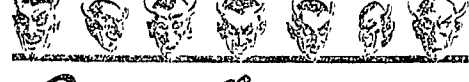
