

**BULLINGER URGES SAFETY FOR HOME**

Domestic Accidents Equal Injuries in Factory Work, Industrial Head Asserts in Talk

Lack of simple precautions results in the death of as many people in the home as in modern industrial plants, was maintained by Prof. Clarence E. Bullinger, of the department of industrial engineering, in the fifth non-technical engineering lecture last night.

Talking as his topic, "How Safe Is Your Home?" Professor Bullinger showed that education in simple engineering precautions would eliminate many accidental deaths.

"In 1925," the professor asserted, "21,000 men were killed in factories compared to a like number in domestic accidents."

"Tabulation of statistics show in the lecture indicated that falls, burns, scalds, asphyxiation, suffocation, fires, and electricity caused most of the injuries in the modern home."

The fact that the chain newspaper is in, but not of the community in which it is published, will bring both the demand and the opportunity for the type of journalism, Mr. Baxter remarked.

In concluding his remarks the speaker maintained that newspaper work is one vocation in which one cannot cover up dishonesty.

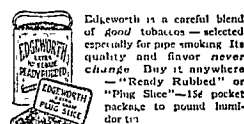

Brown President Believes Knowledge Important in Life After Death

"Duration of time cannot be the main factor in eternal life," Dr. Clarence A. Barbour, president of Brown University, explained to the chapel audience in Schwab auditorium Sunday.

"Knowledge is of primary importance in life, but knowledge itself is of no importance unless it changes or better a man's personality," Dr. Barbour asserted.

He divided the present-day writings into two schools. The first is composed of the cynics who have a bitter outlook on life, and the second school strives constantly to create a better understanding between men, he declared.

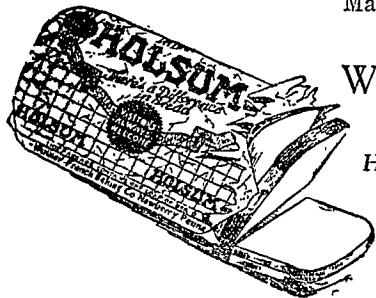
