As head of the department of English literature, he secured international prominence for critical writings on American literature. Last year he resigned his position here to take the post of visiting lecturer at Rollins college, Fla.

"For his constructive work in developing literary activities at the College, and for his Alma Mater, written in 1901, Dr. Pattee has become a popular figure to every Penn State student," was the opinion of Dr. William S. Dye, present head of the English literature department, who is in charge of the course.
