

LION CUBS ENGAGE BELLEFONTE TODAY

Invaide Prepster's Territory This Afternoon—Play Wyoming At Home Tomorrow

Completing its schedule for the current season, the Penn State freshman baseball team will meet Bellefonte academy at 2:30 o'clock this afternoon on the prepster's field and will engage Wyoming tomorrow here at 2:15 o'clock tomorrow afternoon on the Varsity diamond.

Paul Winn, Lion moundsman who has as yet to pitch a major contest for the plebes, will hurl for the yearling against Bellefonte. Houck intended to use Winn against Wyoming yesterday but the contest was postponed on account of rain.

Either Ben Minton or Bud Hoguet will handle the mound assignment for the Nittany nine tomorrow afternoon against the Wyoming aggregation, who are rated as one of the strongest eastern batting outfits.

Paul Swann, steady Lion catcher, who with each succeeding contest adds additional weight to his sterling record, will handle the deliveries for both contests.

Houck will start the same line-up that he used in the team's contest against Colgate on its foreign invasion. Fulvio, however, may see service at short stop, while Weber probably will see action in an outfield position.

The Freshmen record to date shows a win over Kiski Prep and losses to Bucknell plebes and Colgate yearlings. The scheduled contest with Syracuse was cancelled by the Hillmen.

WOLFF WILL QUIT PROFESSIONAL RING

Miss Genevieve Schiffman To Wed Former Penn State Captain, Boxing Champion

Allie Wolff, former Lion boxing captain, who has been successfully launched on a professional ring career, plans to leave the squared arena after his next fight in Madison Square Garden.

Announcement of the engagement of Miss Genevieve Schiffman, of Allentown, to the 1929 Nittany leader, followed closely on the report that Wolff would end his boxing days in the near future.

During his college days Allie was undefeated in the middleweight class, winning the intercollegiate championship three years in succession. Since his debut as a professional fighter he has won five fights, all over the knockout route.

Wolff is at present athletic director at James Madison high school, of Brooklyn, N. Y. He intends to continue this work after his marriage.

Athletes Attain Higher Grades Than Other Students, Statistics Reveal

That athletes have a higher average scholastic standing than non-athletes among the male students at Penn State was revealed in an unofficial report compiled by a psychology student last week.

In every respect, except extreme high scholarship levels, the varsity letter men scholastically surpass non-athletes. However, the non-group exceeds all athletes in the higher planes, but in the lower levels the athletes are above the non-athletes.

In the research, grades of sixty-three athletes, forty-four of whom were letter men, and 2601 non-athletes were used. Only the three upper classes were studied.

Although the non-athletes excel in the first grade levels, it was shown that athletes surpass them in the next two planes. The difference in failures is slight, but letter groups have a slightly lower percentage of failures than non-athletes.

Athletes Average 1.1
Among varsity letter men 99.9 percent are rated from three to two, 59.99 percent from two to one, and 31.81 percent from one to zero. No varsity letter men received failures.
