Irish Poet Narrates Tales That Charmed Children for Generations

CLAIMS IMPROVED LIGHT KILLED OLD TRADITION

A bit of old Erin drifted into Schwab auditorium last night. A "Shanachie," Irish story teller, stepped to the platform, and despite the lack of a hearth fire, candle light, and the intimacy of a thatched roof cottage, he drew his audience about him, and speaking softly, told them stories that have charmed children and grown-ups for generations.

Explaining the actual place of the story-teller in Ireland, Padraic Colum, poet and dramatist lecturing in the English Institute this week, settled into his chair and spoke, while his listeners leaned forward to catch his every word.
